### ***Men’s Golf Invitational***

### ***Junior Discretionary Passes (FINAL DATES)***

Golfers under the age of 14 must golf with a responsible adult or obtain a Junior Discretionary Pass. This pass is available to members 10 years of age and older. This pass is not available to members under the age of 10 or nonmembers. To obtain the pass, written and practical exams will be administered. The candidate must answer a minimum of 90% of the questions correctly and demonstrate the knowledge of essential golf rules and etiquette. Testing sessions must be arranged in advance and can be scheduled with a pro shop staff member. A Junior Discretionary card will be issued and must be presented with the member card prior to golf play. **Members who obtained a JD pass last season do not need to complete this process again.** Please call the pro shop to schedule a testing session for your child or email Brenda at [questions@gerogetowncc.org](mailto:questions@gerogetowncc.org) **Registration for a testing session must be done in advance to ensure instructors are available.** The testing schedule is as follows:

June 12 (Tuesday 4 p.m.); June 16 (Saturday 4 p.m.); June 24 (Sunday 3 p.m. and 4 p.m.)

**Note: Pool space will be limited for open swim beginning June 4-June 15 from 4- 8 p.m. due to team practice. Practice will move to morning sessions beginning Monday, June 18.**

### ***Top of the Pool Parties (Help Needed)***

The first Top of the Pool party is scheduled for Friday, June 15 at 9:00 p.m. We will be showing *Happy Feet*, which is a ‘G’ rated movie. Our second Top of the Pool party is scheduled for Saturday, June 16 at 9:00 p.m. and we will be showing *High School Musical*, which is a ‘PG’ rated movie. **Non-members are welcome so bring a guest!** The cost of admission is \$5/person, which includes lemonade and popcorn. Additional food items will be available for purchase.

In order to make this movie night a success, we need your help! The following positions must be filled:

**Admissions:** Accept payments at the pool gate (commitment ~ 8:45 p.m.-9:45 p.m.)

**Food Preparation:** Fill popcorn bags and make lemonade (commitment ~ 8:45 p.m. – 10:15 p.m.)

**Technical Support:** Help set-up video equipment; trouble-shoot issues that come up (commitment 8:45 p.m.-movie end)

**Clean-up Crew:** Sweep-up popcorn, move chairs back into place (commitment ~ 30 minutes after movie wraps)

### ***Swim/Dive Registration (Wednesday, June 6<sup>th</sup> last day to order apparel)***

**If you are interested in ordering team apparel (does not include swimsuits), your order must be submitted by the end of the day on Wednesday, June 6.** This will be the final apparel order for the season. The pro shop is open daily from 8 a.m.-9 p.m. for your convenience.

Team suits can be ordered at Sun 'N Snow, located off Stadium and Jackson Road. Simply tell the sales associate that you are from the Georgetown Country Club and they will help you order the appropriate suit!

Thanks to everyone that registered to help with a social event and swim/dive meet! We have quite a few positions left to fill, so please watch for information regarding how you can get involved and help your GTCC team be the best that it can be!

### ***Bike Racks***

The club provides three bike racks for members to secure their bicycles. Two racks are located close to the dumpster (one is up against the pool fence, to the side of the dumpster) and the other rack is located by the pool gate attendant desk.

### ***Handicap Parking Spaces***

Just a reminder that the parking spaces allocated for handicap licensed vehicles may not be used as a pick-up/drop-off location. The law mandates that we must keep these spaces open for patrons that have a need for them. We appreciate your cooperation.

### ***Proper Pro Shop Attire***

When entering the pro shop, patrons are required to wear proper footwear. This means some type of shoe, whether it is a flip-flop sandal or closed-toe shoe.

### ***Pool Safety Breaks***

The pool staff be calling for several 'Safety Breaks' on a daily basis throughout the summer. These breaks were previously called 'Adult Swims'. The purpose of these breaks is to encourage children to use the restroom, check the diapers of small children, reapply sunscreen, and ensure that the children are well hydrated. The breaks will be 10 minutes in length and will occur at 2:00, 4:00 and 6:00 p.m. everyday.

### ***Shower Supervision***

Parents, we need your help with this! Kids are using the showers excessively and using the shower wand in the handicap stall for water fights. We would like your assistance in supervising these areas.

### ***Membership Cards***

As stated in the newsletter last fall, we will be using the same membership cards this season. Members unable to locate their membership cards may purchase replacements cards for \$1.00. We are also offering small key chain cards this season for \$2.00. New cards may be purchased during normal business hours in the pro shop.

### ***Guest Passes***

- **PRE-PAY:** Members may purchase pool and tennis court guest passes in the pro shop during normal business hours. In an effort to improve customer service, we are allowing members to prepay for guest passes. For example, you may pay for 10 guest passes (or any amount that you choose) in the pro shop at the beginning of the season. The fee for guest passes is \$6/person. This will be recorded on your membership account. When you arrive to use the facility, you will not need to visit the pro shop, you can proceed directly to the pool gate, where the attendant will issue your guests wristbands. Again, we are asking for your patience the next few days as we work out the glitches in the computer system.

- **LOCAL GUEST PASS POLICY:** The guest pass policy has changed this season. We allow local guests (those that live within a 30 mile radius of the Club) to visit the Club 3 times during the season. We ask for your cooperation as we enforce this policy to preserve the integrity of the Club.
- **OUT-OF-TOWN GUEST PASS POLICY:** Out-of-town guests may purchase a one week (7 day) pool pass for \$25/person.
- Guests wishing to use the golf course will pay normal greens fees.
- A reminder that all guests must be with a member at all times while at the facility.

### *Accompaniment Passes*

One accompaniment pass per membership may be purchased at the pro shop for the 2007 season. The cost is \$50.00. **Accompaniment pass holders are not allowed to bring guests.** This pass may be purchased by members who meet one of the following conditions:

1. Members who work outside of the home or who work in the home but are unable to come to the facility and would like to have their children utilize the Club in their absence may choose to purchase an accompaniment pass for the caretaker of their children. The caretaker may not use the facility when the parents/legal guardians are present.
2. Members who have two or more small children (at least two children must be under the age of 3) who require assistance when utilizing the facilities in the absence of a second parent/legal guardian. The intended use of the pass in this situation is for one parent/legal guardian and a caretaker to provide the necessary care of the children. The pass may not be utilized when two parents or legal guardians are present. Management approval required
3. Members with special needs children who require assistance when utilizing the facilities. Management approval required

**Note: Accompaniment pass holders have access to the pool but must pay to play a round of golf.**

### *2007 Trial Membership*

If you have friends or family who have been contemplating the purchase of a membership to the Club, our 2007 trial membership may be just what they have been waiting for. Potential members pay the annual dues in the category of their choice plus \$100. This defers the initiation fee until the 2008 membership renewal period. If the family decides to renew the membership for the 2008 season, we will credit \$100 to the initiation fee (3 year payment options available) at that time. What's in this for you? Besides meeting community members and making new friends, your name will be entered in a drawing for a free membership for the 2008 season for every new member that lists you as a referral.
