President's Column

A warm welcome to all new members at GTCC! We are excited to have you at our club and hope that this is the beginning of many good years together!

It was suggested by a new member that a quick review of basic club protocol and services would be helpful; please find below a summary to that end.

Membership

- This is a member owned club; if you are a member in good standing you own part of the club!
- If there is something that we can improve, please let us know and, if possible, help us implement the improvement by volunteering.
- You may join the Men's and Women's Golf Leagues as a member and your kids may join our aquatics teams and programs.
- You are welcome to join our board meetings, typically help on the 3rd Tuesday of each month (the next one is June 16 at 7pm in the clubhouse).

Services

- You may rent the clubhouse for a small fee for a private party.
- Wireless internet access will be up and running soon on the pool deck.

- Grills are available for your use at any time.
- The snack window will be open during pool hours, weather permitting. You may add funds to your "Splash Card" (snack window account) and authorize your children to use the accounting (eliminating the need for kids to carry money).
- If you refer a new family Trial Member that joins, you will receive \$100 (cash or club credit at the snack window).

Pool Protocol

- Children wearing diapers must wear a plastic diaper cover over the diaper. If you forget them, the lifeguards will remind you that they are available for purchase at the snack window.
- Every 2 hours at peak swim times, the Lifeguards will call a "Safety Check" for 10 minutes. The purpose is to give the kids a break to use the bathroom, get a snack, etc. Adults may swim during these breaks.
- Chairs are available on a first come first serve basis. We ask that at peak times children swimming do not reserve chairs by placing their towels on the chairs if they are not going to use them for hours. This courtesy allows adults who are not swimming to have a chair.
- Drinks are allowed on the pool deck (no glass); food is not (health code rule). All food must be consumed in the Food Area (fenced in area with grills).
- You may bring your own food and drinks.

If you have any questions, please feel free to ask any of the staff.

Treasurer's Column

We've had a great start to the pool season with many new families joining the existing members at the club. Thanks to many of you, we have had over 20 new trial members join in the last few weeks as referrals. This recent push has put us at 98% of our membership goal. This is a very solid position relative to years past and now we want to continue the momentum to exceed our forecasts.

In 2009 we've already completed paving the picnic area, reconditioning tennis courts 1 and 2 and installing a privacy curtain in the women's locker room. By surpassing membership revenue goals, we are positioned to complete other club improvements identified by member feedback.
